His slide show presented some real data from Road America and how drivers could use the information to go faster. Kind of the ultimate goal of racing.

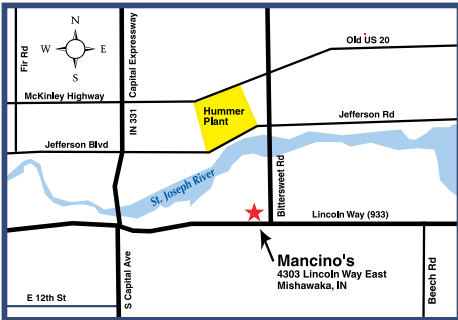

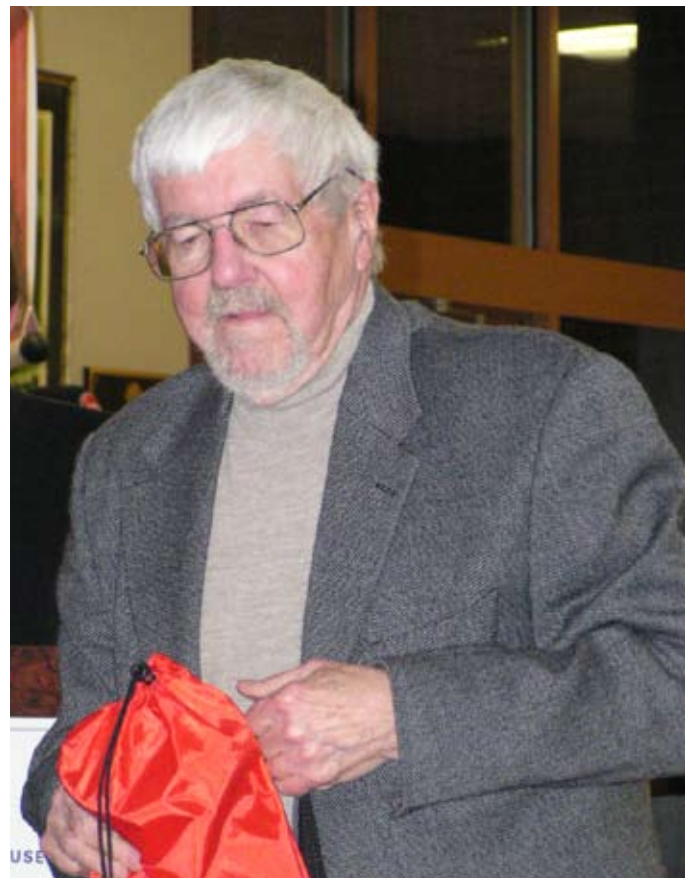

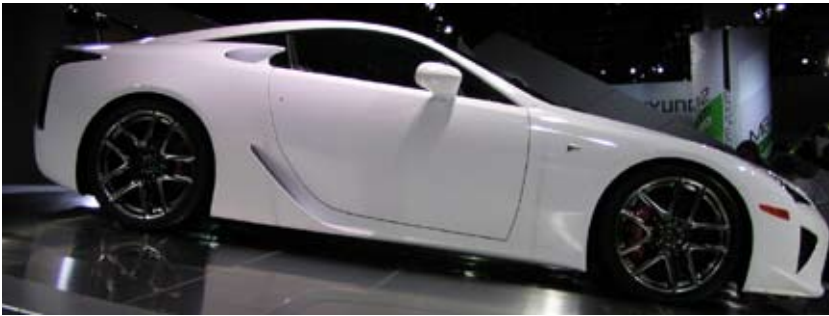
