With the holiday 4<sup>th</sup> and no general membership meeting, I will try to update everyone on the activities since the June meeting. Instead of reminding everyone of all our July events already in our calendar and noted elsewhere in this issue, I will concentrate on the Divisional and National updates. I recently attended a virtual meeting with SCCA leadership support team, along with all the other RE's on 6/20 covering several programs and updates as follows:

#### **2024 Convention Plans**

The SCCA National Convention will continue to be virtual to better serve a boarder audience. In 2023 the Board of Directors approved preliminary financial support along with continued personnel support from the National Office to the Divisional Conventions in 2024. By investing in these conventions, the SCCA National Office demonstrates its commitment to fostering a thriving motorsports community and providing SCCA members with valuable resources. The National Office will be reaching out directly to Divisional Convention planners to coordinate these efforts and offer support.

#### **SCCA Academy Update**

The Solo Safety Committee worked with the SCCA Academy to develop the online Solo Safety Stewards (SSS) course, which is now LIVE and available via the SCCA Academy Learning Management System (LMS). If you are renewing your SSS license in May 2023 and beyond, completing the online course is required. # MOTORSTATE CHALLENGE

WHAT: Lane Automotive Motorstate Challenge (Pro Touring event)

WHEN: July 20/21/22

(20th—Registration, Cruise, Dinner at Waco Beach)

(21st—Track day at Gingerman Raceway in South Haven Michigan)

(22nd—Autocross at Tire Rack in South Bend Indiana)

Come and join us as we welcome approximately 90 entrants that are vying for a trip to the "Ultimate Street Car competition". The cars are amazing as vintage cars with many, many upgrades (suspension, motors, safety, etc.)

This is a South Bend Region sponsored event and all entrants must be SCCA members (full or weekend) and must sign SCCA waiver. This enables us to cover everyone under SCCA competition insurance. All workers will be supplied lunch, a t-shirt, and \$40 per day. Also they get to see some of the fastest cars and drivers in the country.

There will be a cruise on Thursday that ends up at Waco Beach and treated to a BBQ dinner (free to SBR members). Then on Friday morning the SBR team does Tech inspection followed by Time Trial action on the track at which point we become corner workers. This is an important job as to make sure all the participants are safe. At the end of Friday there is an ice cream social that you won't want to miss. On Saturday we move to the Tire Rack for a good old shootout on the test track autocross style. We need about 15-20 workers to help chase cones, do tech (if not done on Friday) work grid, timing, announcing, and so forth. Again you will be provided lunch and \$40 for the day.

This is a very important event for SBR as it helps pay for our racing and other member things such as Ball games and bus trips. Plan on coming out and help make this event the best we can and really enjoyable for the competitors.
