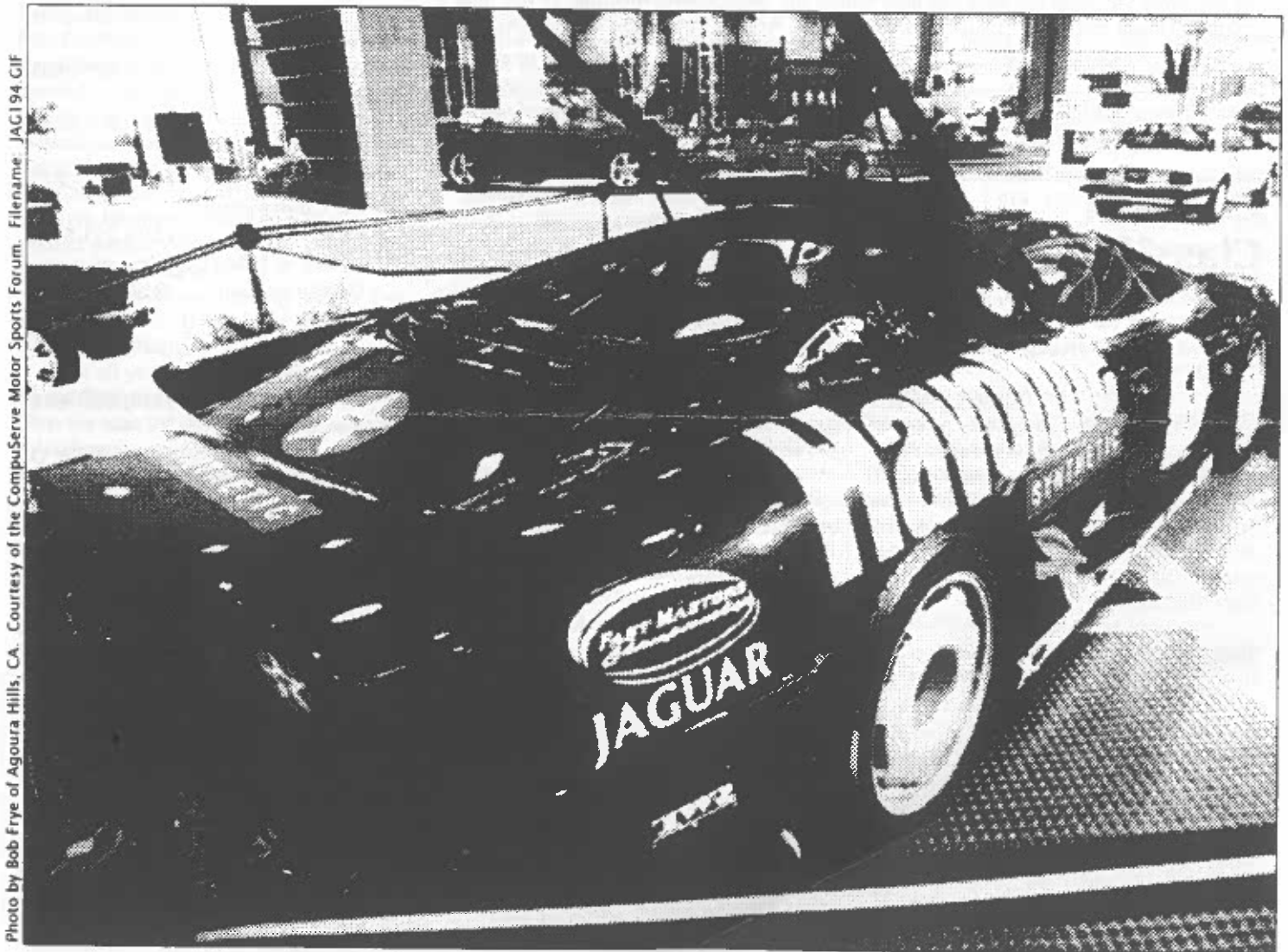

The buffet-style dinner was tasty, consisting of Carved Top Sirloin of Beef and Charbroiled Marinated Chicken, although SBR's Regional Executive for 1993 and Master of Ceremonies for the evening, Bill Farr, claimed that the lobster at his table was just wonderful. Go figure!

Our very special guest and featured speaker for the evening was Tony Dowe, Managing Director of Tom Walkinshaw Racing. Mr. Dowe spoke on a variety of subjects, shared several very amusing stories, and fielded questions from the audience. One favorite topic of the evening was the TWR-prepared Jaguar XJ220 FastMasters cars (sometimes wryly referred to as "CrashMasters" due to the boundless enthusiasm of the veteran drivers in the series). A photo of TWR-prepared FastMasters XJ220 #1 appears on the cover of this issue. Mr. Dowe was very entertaining, and his contribution to making this a most enjoyable evening was appreciated by all.

On to the awards! The Red Bud Trophy goes to the male member who achieves the most points in Solo and Rally competition combined. The winner of the Red Bud for 1993 is George Williams.

The Thomas Trophy is awarded to the female member who achieves the most points in Solo and Rally competition combined. Winning the Thomas Trophy for 1993 is Lynnette Markowicz.

The Boone Memorial Trophy is awarded to the Region's top Scrutineer. This year's winner is Rod Markowicz, who carried on the time-honored tradition of

drinking a toast from the "Loving Cup"-style trophy.

The Walker Award is bestowed upon the South Bend Region member who, during the course of the year, showed more enthusiasm for the Sport and the Club than did any other. For 1993, this was Bev Farran, who, when she wasn't bringing A.M. General Hummers to Solo II events, helping get PitBoard ready to mail, and auto-crossing the family DSP Rabbit, was helping put together both the 40th Anniversary Party and the Annual Awards Banquet. Talk about enthusiasm!

The Harold Miller Jr. Award is awarded to the "Best New Driver" in Club Racing. This year's award goes to Seth Ravendal.

SBR awarded two of its members with Hero Driver Awards. 1993 Solo II National Champions Joyce Looman and Steve Tamandli, who have won 13 and 4 Solo II National Championships respectively, would be heroes in anyone's book.

Awards for the CENDIV Points Series (Club Racing) were presented to Warren White, who drove his Formula Continental to a 1st Place finish in the Series. Also receiving an award for the Series was Paul McBride, who drove his F440 to a 2nd Place finish in the Series.

Awards of Merit were awarded to their special efforts in various areas. The awardees were Don Fore, who breathed renewed life into PitBoard as Editor, Bill Ozinga, for his innovative contributions to SBR's Solo II Program, and Race Chairman Dennis Jennings, for his efforts in chairing the Region's successful race at Grattan.

Certificates of Appreciation were awarded to Hans Haus for allowing us the use of their banquet facilities for our

monthly membership meetings, The Tire Rack for sponsoring our successful Solo II Series and providing such a nice autocross facility, Elkhart Community School Corporation for allowing us the use of our own Elkhart Lake - the parking lot at Memorial High School, Michigan City Rogers High School for allowing us the use of the huge parking lot at the school for our Summer Festival Solo, Western Michigan Region, SCCA, our Most Favored Region, for all their assistance in our Region's return to a racing region, and last but certainly not least, Tony Dowe, featured speaker at the Awards Banquet, for joining us and sharing his thoughts on the world of racing.
