## **Unique Incentives Offered to the Club Racing** Community Jeff Luckritz

This article is going to "toot our own horn." The South Bend Region of SCCA does many things very well. Not only do a good number of SBR members autocross, but they work races, car shows and a few of you even race. Due to Jim Desenberg's great leadership as Race Chair, SBR also puts on one of the best races in the Central Division....period!

As a racer, I can appreciate how costly entry fees can be. The June Sprints and the National at Indianapolis Raceway Park were \$250 each. That's a good chunk of money. As an incentive for drivers to attend our race, the South Bend Sprints, we offer each racer a \$25 rebate on their entry fee if they raced with us the previous year. Twenty five dollars won't put your kids through college, but it'll buy the family dinner at Burger King.

On top of that, we also offer a \$25 rebate if the racer won at our race the previous year. Since our race is a double event, that means a driver that won both races could earn \$50 plus an additional \$25 for coming back the next year. Seventy five dollars will also buy you some ice cream at Sherman's on Phoenix road near exit 20 in addition to an upgrade from Burger King to Big Boy's.

I truly believe that this has something to do with the rising car count at our races. When we first started at GingerMan, we had as few as 60-70 cars. For the past two years we have averaged over a hundred. As a non-profit organization, the SBR Board of Directors deemed this rebate program essential to establish good-will between us and the racers who come race with us. There is no reason for the region to make tens of thousands of dollars for a race. Sure it's nice to be in the black to help make our region and race even stronger, but there should be a limit.

More importantly, we treat the racers right. We stay on schedule, feed everybody a good meal, and treat people nicely. If a racer feels "assaulted" by a chief or tech person, are they going to come back? Hell no! Luckily, we have a multitude of members that treat our "guests" appropriately.

This goes for the workers too. We also have an incentive plan for SBR members to work our race. When we first started racing, we were criticized for not having enough workers, especially chiefs. To encourage fellow SBR members to work our See "Incentives" on p. 6






