What would you like to see changed at the National level of SCCA?

Kim: Several things: A) Better representation of the views of actual participants by the members of the governing Boards. The Solo Board seems bent on revising rules to attempt to lure folks to change classes, while putting those currently in the class(es) at a disadvantage. B) Assistance from the national office in getting autocross sites. For instance, the National Office could take the lead in negotiating at the corporate level of major corporations who have large parking facili-

ties, to gain access to those lots for local region solo activities across the country. C) A better site for the Solo II National Championships. The current site is a car-killer, with potholes that can swallow my car. D) Getting out of Drifting. I see Drifting as a way to gain enough negative publicity to adversely affect many of our core activities, including Solo and Rally.

Jeff: More support for the club at the local level.

What would you like to see changed at the Regional level?

Kim: A) Increased emphasis on encouraging our membership to take an active role in their club. B) Evaluation of all club activities to make certain we are spending our members' funds to support activities they are interested in, and that provide the most return for them. C) Locating and securing another high quality Solo site.

Jeff: Increased member participation. We have 10% of the people doing 90% of the work. If everyone would pitch in, our activities would be so much better, and there would be more activities to enjoy.
