



# Attention Solo Drivers and SBR Members

The South Bend Region will be hosting a National level Road Race at GingerMan Raceway August 25 and 26. We will need many SBR members to volunteer to help put this event on successfully. One of the places we need to provide manpower is gate security. For this purpose I am hoping to organize a group of SBR Solo people to handle the gate security. The job is quite simple; just check everyone's credentials as they come to the gate and if they do not have the correct credentials just send them back to registration. Everyone will be admitted after they sign the waiver and if required, pay the fee.

What is in it for you? SBR will allow the race workers (gate security) to drive their vehicles on the race course during the lunch period on Saturday and Sunday. These will be "brisk" laps with some limited control by the pace car. These will not be completely "hot" laps but you will have some opportunity to drive your car on a closed course at a much higher speed than you will normally get at any Solo event. All cars must have and effective muffler and a cursory safety inspection just as at a solo will be required.

Also, all race workers are provided with meals both Saturday and Sunday. Saturday and Sunday morning there will be continental type breakfast. A box lunch will be provided both Saturday and Sunday. Saturday evening there will be a full dinner party with beer and wine for all the race workers. You do not have to be there both days. You do not have to be an SBR member to volunteer. SBR has a few trial memberships available for non-members to come and participate at the Road Race.

I'm hoping to get at least 4 or 5 (hopefully more) Solo people who want to try their driving skills on the GingerMan course in exchange for a few hours at the gate. If we get a good number of volunteers, no one will have to spend more then a few hours at the gate.

If you are interested in helping please contact myself or race Chairman Paul McBride (contact information on page 3 of this issue).

This is a good opportunity to experience another form of SCCA Motorsports and see if you want to expand your SCCA activities.


