Approved minutes from 8-7-07.

<u>TREASURER'S REPORT</u>- H.C. Colwell: We are in the black for the first time in many months! Had we not been required to pay for a National Towing Fee for each entry at our National Race, we would have shown a profit for the race. Not all fees have been received/paid to date for the race.

#### MEMBERSHIP: 166

<u>SOLO</u>-Kim Bollinger: No activity in August. Next SOLO scheduled for September 9<sup>th</sup> at Tire Rack.

RACE- Paul McBride: 92 cars were entered at our National Race August 25-26. We needed 93 to break even! SBR had over 30 members support this event. Experienced workers were a concern for putting on the race-we need a minimum of 7 for the corners. Track waivers were an issue that should be addressed for next year. Our Registrar, Kendra Phillips, came out of WMR and was the only one available in the Division! Driver's comments were positive, as were those from workers outside of our region. The food was considered very good and at least every worker had the opportunity to win at least two door prizes (Thanks to Tire Rack and Hoosier Racing Tire). The drivers donated \$400 for worker's door prizes. Looking forward, we may want to consider partnering with another Great Lakes Region (WMR?) for a Regional/National or Double National in 2008 as the national races will be reduced from 7 to 6. The board was also in favor of supporting the 2008 Driver's Training School at Nelsons Ledges (proposed) with volunteers from SBR.
