# SBR MEETING MINUTES (12-4-07)

<u>ATTENDEES</u>: William Loring, Paul McBride, H.C. Colwell, Jeff Luckritz, Mark Manninen

Approved minutes from 11-6-07.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT- H.C. Colwell:

INCOME: Another positive cash-flow month where income exceeded expenses. A 6 month Certificate of Deposit was purchased for some of our cash reserves.

#### MEMBERSHIP: 158

#### SOLO-Mark Manninen:

Mark presented the SOLO budget spread sheet for the year. SOLO racing in 2007 had pulled in twice the anticipated budgeted income! The 2008 kick-off meeting will be held at Tire Rack, Saturday morning January 26. We have locked in Tire Rack SOLO dates for next year while others are still being negotiated. We discussed requirements for a SOLO vehicle to tow the club trailer as well as to also replace the van currently being donated by Lloyd Loring. Preference is for a small used airport shuttle vehicle with lots of windows. We hope to make a purchase before March of next year. Mark feels our single-axle trailer should be able to last about two more years before it will need to be replaced.

#### RACE-Paul McBride:

Dave Dawson will be the Assistant Race Chair in 2008. GLD Stewards/Workers Seminar will be held March 7-8 in Toledo, Ohio. Paul/Dave are investigating a Formula only Regional Race on the Saturday of our National Race weekend (August 23-24) including Formula and Club Continentals, Formula 1<sup>st</sup>, Formula Vees, and Super Vees.

<u>PROGRAM CHAIR</u>: Looking for a speaker for the January Banquet at Studebaker.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u>: Paul McBride, Jim Desenberg, and H.C. Colwell will be reimbursed for their registration fees representing our club at the Round Table in Ft. Wayne.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: No general meeting in January due to the banquet on the 19<sup>th</sup>. Street Survival Schools will be held at Tire Rack in 2008. SBR will observe and train at the 1<sup>st</sup> event. Adam Lewis will head this up as we work our way into the 4 event program for the year. We also discussed details for the January Banquet including door prizes, traveling trophies, video displays, and presentations.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT- H.C. Colwell:

EXPENSES were incurred for the January Banquet and SOLO trophies.

MEMBERSHIP: 157

SOLO-Mark Manninen: January SOLO Planning Meeting and Scoring System Report were made. Lake Michigan College is not open to SOLO events. Reviewed SOLO 2008 budget. Event fees were increased due to insurance and SCCA cost increases. Grissom remains on the schedule, although nothing currently planned. A 16' trailer with windows and a portable generator for SBR SCCA equipment, timing & scoring apparatus, and personnel was approved to be purchased. It will replace our existing trailer and Lloyd Loring's van. Mark made the motion for this expenditure, it was seconded by Bill and approved by the board. Once the new trailer has been purchased and retrofitted, the current trailer will be posted for sale on our website

STREET SURVIVAL SCHOOL- No report-Adam Lewis absent.

RACE-Paul McBride: Our National Race in August will also host a Double Regional Restricted event for Club Formula Continentals. This will be their premier race of the summer and expect to have from 12 to 20 cars entered. 50% of the Gingerman track rental fees have been made and the contract is being negotiated. Paul still has not received a steward's report for the 2007 National. Great Lakes Division has not decided yet on how to handle paying for this year's Driver's School. We have not paid the "fees" for the 2007 Driver's School until this issue is resolved.

OLD BUSINESS: It is suggested that we start next year's banquet one half hour earlier and remain one half hour later for additional museum viewing and socializing time. We will not be taking part in the Cavalcade of Wheels this year (its last year at the Joyce Center), opting instead to focusing on the Street Survival School series.
