Here are the reports:

Event #1 on 4/19 at TTR had 43 drivers, 7 of which were Weekend Members. Usual April conditions with occasional moisture but not worthy of rain tires. At least it was not cold enough to shatter cones like we have done in the past. This is the earliest we can normally hold a solo in this part of the country. We may have had some radio and FM transmitter issues but everything worked at the next event (Black Helicopters???).

Closest battles were in G-Stock with 9/10th spread for the whole class with 3 drivers. James Rose with his Neon SRT-4 was new to G Stock this year due to restructuring and pushed the field to perform.

Stock Ladies Fastest was Cailin Kennedy in a certain blue Celica. I think it was Cailin's first solo driving a car and not a kart. We also had 10 Novices (Novi?) participate.



Top of the PAX Index was Keith Candiotti in a DS Audi TT AWD. The AWD and consistent driving put Keith at the top easily.

Event #2 on 5/3 at TTR had 73 drivers, 15 of which were Weekend Members. Fantastic weather conditions prevailed for a downright perfect day for solo. The Seven Turns

Several members have asked "How's the Locost Seven project coming?" I am making progress. At time it seems the progress is slow then a flurry of parts show up via UPS and I am back to welding and grinding.

The goal is to have the rolling chassis painted and the car sitting on its own suspension by the end of the summer and I am please to say I am on schedule. I look back at my original log entries and see that the first frame welds occurred on Memorial Day last year. I assumed a two-year build duration and that looks about right. It is always time vs. money.

The latest development is the completion of the front suspension and steering system. As noted in previous posts, this can take awhile. Lots of things can work, or not work and have to be redone, but I sure as hell want to be confident that the car goes in the direction I point it! I find this part of the build very satisfying, lots of shiny moving parts that look "racy". I located a better quick ratio steering rack on eBay for a very fair price. The unit is made by Coleman and is the exact width I needed to fit the chassis and minimize bump steer. It is fairly quick at 2.5:1. I just hope I don't need arms like Popeye to turn the car with big fat sticky tires in front. The rest of the steering parts are new and provide lots of adjustment. The entire front suspension on the car has an amazing amount of adjustment. More variables give more options and flexibility along with a corresponding longer time to get it dialed in right.

Another eBay find was the coil-over shocks. This is a spot on a race car you can really drop some "serious coin". My wish list included aluminum double adjustable Koni 3012 monotube shocks but the wallet said otherwise. I ended up with two sets of brand new single adjustable (rebound only) aluminum shocks from Strange Engineering for the rear and Alden Eagle for the front end. I got them at less than 1/4th the cost of the Konis. Both sets included free springs that should be very close to the spring rate I needed. Konis will have to wait until my sponsor comes thru or the kids graduate from college.

Next I move to cooling system, seat, pedals, battery, and fuel cell mounts. Once all the brackets are fixed, the chassis goes to paint.
