SBR SOLO Events #3 and #4

The South Bend Region ended up starting off the [GLDiv Solo Series](#) this year with the first two GLDiv Solo Series events held at Grissom Aeroplex in Peru, IN. This was also South Bend Region Solo Championship points events #3 & #4. Great Lakes soloists are a flexible and friendly group and we tend to just roll with things. We did just that on June 6th and 7th under the mostly sunny skies of north central Indiana. We rolled, rocked, and raced around the cones on one of the Midwest's legendary solo venues while being serenaded by the sounds of high-thrust turbofan jet engines in a typical June weekend at Peru, IN.

The weather was more than pleasant for the entire weekend with no rain, lightning, or other bizarre weather phenomenon usually expected at this location. The only thing hot was the tires and drivers of the Great Lakes Division as they competed with four runs each day without significant incident. Each day was scored as a separate points event for the GLDiv Solo Series and weekend trophies were issued on the combined two-day time like a Tour event. If you could only run one day, you still could get your winning 100 pts for one series event. 98 drivers ran on Saturday and 91 drivers ran on Sunday.

The course design by Dave Gushwa of South Bend Region on Saturday was different from the usual open

"road race" course some have come to expect at this large venue. The course on both days incorporated the entire main area in the course design utilizing a remote grid area similar to the Peru National Tour from last year. The Saturday course was visually intimidating to some with a few optical tricks leading one to think it was a lot tighter when walking the course that it actually was while driving it. Dave picked up some ideas from last year's Nationals and Tour events and made a course design that paid off well if you concentrated on utilizing good solo driving fundamentals like looking way ahead, being smooth, and driving the best line. You could not drive to the cones and get a good run. One optional slalom area was the subject of much debate during the walks. A lot of "give up some here to get more there" discussion was overheard. Some of the national level drivers said to expect more of this type of course at national events in the future. Did I mention the course was long? Wow. You definitely could not hold your breath for the whole run. When you finished you knew some effort was involved.

The drivers that had no issues with looking way ahead on Saturday were Clemens Burger in his B Mod LeGrand Mk18, Mark Lamm in a C Mod 73 Dulon Mp5, and Don Elzinga in another C Mod 84 Reynard taking the top three in PAX index for the day. The Mod drivers obviously have the looking ahead part down pat. Some of the closest battles Saturday were in C Prepared with Bill Headlee just getting by Scott Lewis by .069 sec and Warren

LeVeque only .093 behind Mr. Lewis! The Street Touring gang were a tight bunch with Will Lahee, Jeff Mabrey, Brian Davis, and Travis Robuck putting on a quite a show. FTD was Clemens Burger from Indy with a 59.232. Fastest Stock Class time was claimed by Bryan Schafer from Cincinnati Region in Super Stock with an impressive 67.324 in a big Corvette (There goes the "too tight" course argument in a flash). Fastest of the Touring Classes was snagged by Will Lahee from Indy with a 71.844. Fastest Jr Kart was Kate Regganie from Chicago with an impressive 74.903!

Sunday's course design was a much more open and "road-racy" layout pleasing those drivers with significant aero, excessive horsepower, and a lust for a good adrenalin rush. Dave Gushwa laid down a good design rewarding any driver with the ability to drive a smooth line. Overall times dropped significantly and the cars ran the run groups fairly quickly in an effort to get all three run groups to run in the dry before the predicted rain showers arrived. The showers never appeared on the horizon, just a couple of C5A heavy transport jets doing touch and go landings resulting in ear splitting roar with their full throttle ascents directly over our event. So much for sound control issues at this solo site!

There was a good battle between co-drivers Albert Chan and Dennis Bay of the Detroit Region, driving the

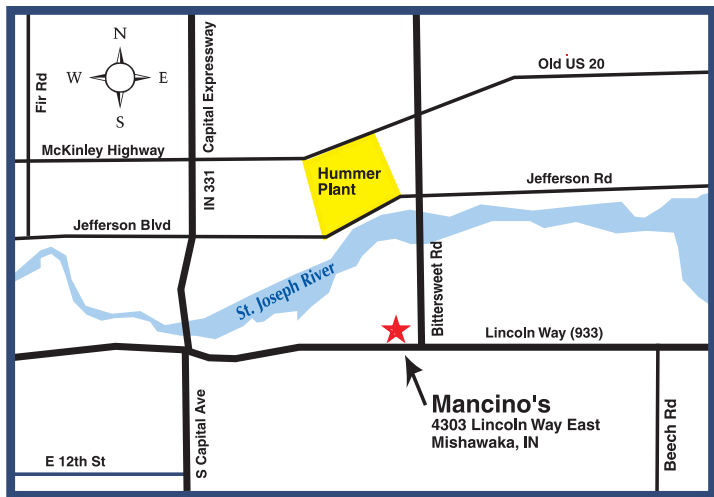
