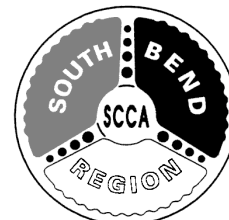

## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. This event will be conducted in strict compliance with the 2002 SCCA General Competition Rules, amendments, CenDiv Regional Rules, and these supplementary regulations.
2. THE ENTRY FEE INCLUDING CAR, DRIVER, TWO FREE CREW PASSES, AND EVENT PIN IS \$150 for one day, \$230 for both days, SRF is \$160 for one Day, \$250 for Two Days. Second driver is additional \$40. Extra crew and guest passes will be available for \$10.00 at registration. Entries must be postmarked no later than Saturday, July 6, 2002. All entries postmarked after this date will be considered late entries and will be subjected to the \$30.00 additional late fee.
3. Telephone entries are not official until the entry form is signed and accepted. All entry forms must be accompanied by the entry fee to be considered an entry. The officials of South Bend Region reserve the right to refuse any entry. The Stewards of the Meeting reserve the right to alter the schedule of events for good and sufficient reason.
4. Cancellation of an entry notification must be received no later than 10:00 PM EST on Thursday, July 11, 2002 by Rebecca Snyder (574) 293-1535, to have an entry fee refunded. Money will be refunded within 21 days after the race. A \$30.00 collection fee will be added to the amount owed by any owner/driver entrant who has a check refused for any reason. Cancellations at the track for mechanical reasons will receive a partial or full refund.

6. All drivers must present a current SCCA membership card and current competition license at registration. Drivers needing competition license or membership confirmation from the SCCA National Office must contact the Chief Registrar by Wednesday, July 10, 2002. A charge of \$5.00 will be assessed to an entrant if the registrar has to call the national office regarding his/her entry (payable at registration). Paddock positions may not be occupied until the driver/entrant registration is completed. A valid SCCA Novice Permit or Full Competition license for Midwest Council, Waterford Hills, and Canadian ASN will be accepted.
7. All persons gaining admittance to the track must display their passes at all times. Admittance to the track is by way of Gate 1 on Phoenix Rd. Do not block the access roads. Sponsors and member's guests are welcome (\$10.00 per pass). Trial membership will be available for \$15.00.
8. THERE WILL BE NO CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TRACK PROPERTY UNTIL AFTER THE LAST CHECKERED FLAG OF THE DAY!
9. The operation of any two-way radios on the following frequencies will NOT be permitted: 151.625, 151.925, 154.600. This is necessary to avoid conflict with track communications.
10. The use of three or four wheel mini-vehicles is permitted only as support vehicles. The mini-vehicle must display car number and class and be driven by valid state licensed persons. Sticker must be obtained at tech. Slow speeds only. Riding on the coachwork or outside of any vehicle is NOT PERMITTED on track property.
11. Drivers receiving a Black Flag will enter pit lane and proceed to the Black Flag station in front of the tower.
12. The grid is the paved area at the North end of the paddock. The grid will be closed and clear of all crew at the one-minute signal. Late arrivals to the grid will be allowed to start at the rear of the field. During all sessions any car entering the paved area west of the pit lane or paddock will be considered retired.
13. Qualifying grid and provisional race results and sound levels will be posted at Driver Information. Final grid sheets and official race results will be available at the Driver Information Center near the tower. Transponders are recommended, but not required.
14. THE FIRST THREE FINISHERS IN EACH CLASS WILL BE IMPOUNDED AFTER THEIR RACE. Additional race vehicles may be impounded following qualifying session. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO REPORT TO THE IMPOUND AREA AT THE BASE OF THE TOWER. Impound will be reached by way of the road at the North end of the pit lane. A maximum of two people, including the driver, will be permitted in the impound area and driver MUST remain with the vehicle until it is released by the Chief Scrutineer or his designated representative.
15. Trophies will be awarded per GCR or better. NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED. Trophies may be picked up after the official results for each race have been posted. Single car classes will receive a Trophy.
16. TRACK RULES: Camping Pass is \$5 per person per night. Children under 12 are free. Pets must be on leashes and owners are responsible for their cleanup. No pets are allowed in the park area around the pavilion and pond.
17. Central Division registered car numbers will be honored, whenever possible, if received by Sunday, June 30, 2002, and may be reserved by phone (574) 293-1535 or e-mail to [rsnyder@atlasdie.com](mailto:rsnyder@atlasdie.com). Confirmation notices may not be sent if you receive your first choice of number.
18. Only SCCA member crew will be allowed in the hot pits. Only one may cross the pit lane for signaling purposes. There will be no smoking in the hot pits. Appropriate attire must be worn.
19. The following cars must be presented to tech for full inspection: T1, SSB (SSA). All others, if you have had an annual tech with no notations in your log book from the time of the annual and have 2002 helmet sticker, you need to bring only your log book and tech form to tech. If annual tech is needed, please contact the Chief Scrutineer Rod Markowicz (574) 232-4206 before Tuesday, July 2, 2002 10:00pm EST to make an appointment.
20. *No parking of race or tow vehicles, or storage of equipment is permitted on the paved paddock or on the grass area at the North end of the paved paddock (including the area North of the Restrooms and Gas tanks) without the permission of the Race Chairman. All competitor's utility or tow vehicles in the paddock must have the proper ID ATTACHED AND VISIBLE.*
21. Sale of products or services on the track property is strictly prohibited without prior permission. Arrangements should be made no later than 10:00 PM on Thursday, July 11, 2002, with the Track Owner, Dan Schnitta, 616-253-4445.
22. The track property must be left clean. The track will be closed at 8:00 PM EDT on Sunday, July 14, 2002. Prior arrangements must be made with Track Owner if cars or items are to be removed after that time.
23. Gas (for sale), water, and air will be available at the track for competitors.
24. Race engines may not be started or run between the hours of 6:30 PM and 8:00 AM EDT and 10:30 AM and Noon on Sunday. All waste oil must be placed in the red barrels provided. The maximum speed limit in all areas except the race course is 10 MPH, slow, reasonable, and prudent. Individuals not driving in that manner will be referred to Chief Steward.
25. Sound Control will be located between turns 2 and 3.
