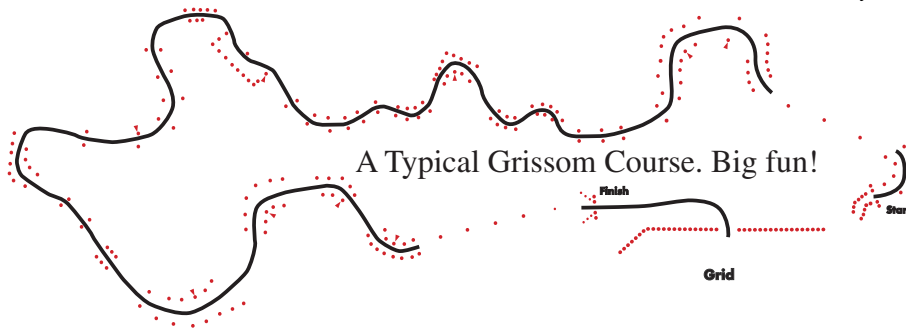


A Sunday at Grissom

the SBR 2004 solo Series



Join us at Grissom Aeroplex in 2004 for SBR's regional solo #4. It's not a Divisional, Tour, or Cendiv Series event so you can concentrate on just having fun. It's good, clean concrete with plenty of room for safe fun. Widely regarded as one of the best autocross sites in Cendiv. The Grissom Aeroplex is about 15 miles north of Kokomo, IN and just south of Peru, IN on US 31. Use the new entrance to the Grissom Aeroplex at the foot of the big water tower about 1 mile south of the Air Museum. Take the first right after entering and follow the SCCA signs.

Trophies and annual points will be awarded for all Standard SCCA classes and ladies classes. (2004 PAX/RTP factors will be used for the Tire Rack and Novice Annual Championships.)

You'll need a safe car, seat belts, an effective muffler, and an approved helmet (Snell 1990 or newer.) A few loaner helmets are available for novices.
