The 3rd and 4th events in the SBR 2010 Solo Series

Join us at Grissom Aeroplex, one of the best known autocross sites in the midwest. The Grissom Aeroplex is about 15 miles north of Kokomo, IN and just south of Peru, IN on US 31. Use the entrance to the Grissom Aeroplex at the foot of the big water tower about 1 mile south of the Air Museum (at about the US31 174.5 mile marker.) Take the first right after entering and turn left before the big building. Stop at the gate to the site.

This event will be scored as two one day events for annual SBR points as well as GLSS Championship points. (2010 PAX/RTP factors will be used for the SBR Tire Rack, Street Tire and Novice Annual Championships.)

IMPORTANT: The entry/exit gate will only be open for 10 minutes at the start of each hour during the event.

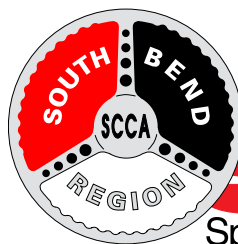
Registration

- Two-day Entry Fee: \$50 for SCCA members, \$60 for guests. One-day only fee: \$40 SCCA members, \$50 guests.
- Entries must be received by May 31. \$15 late fee for entries received after May 28.
- **Event limited to the first 200 entries received.**
- **NO NEW ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT THE EVENT.**
- Register using the "generic" entry forms in any SportsCar, the GLSS Bulletin or the form included in this event flyer. Or online pre-registration at Motorsportreg.com.

- Each car must have the GLSS decal on both sides during the event. Decals available at on-site check-in for \$1.50 ea.
- You'll need a safe car, seat belts, an effective muffler, and an approved helmet (Snell 1995 or newer.) A few loaner helmets are available for novices.
- If you are a minor (under 18) and wish to run, call Kim Bollinger in advance 574-271-0088 or email: kkbollinger@sbcglobal.net for details on the Minor Waiver needed. If you do not call, we may have to deny entry.

Note: Overnight camping is not permitted on site, however self-contained RVs can park in the Air Museum lot for a small fee/donation. A campground is also nearby.
