Compete for the 2013 SBR Solo Regional Class Championships, Novice Championship, and 2013 Tire Rack Championship.

These events are based on SCCA solo regulations. You'll need a safe car, seat belts, an approved helmet (Snell M or SA 2000 or newer). A few loaner helmets will be available.
