Compete for the 2013 SBR Solo Regional Class Championships, Novice Championship, and 2013 Tire Rack Championship.

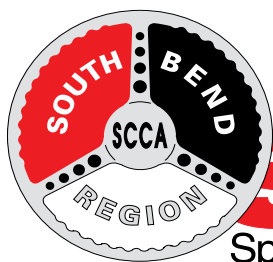
